 - Using writing to solve reading problems

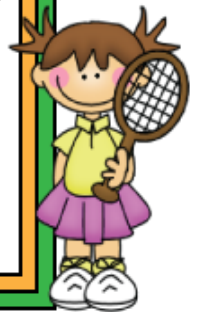


Writing
