Grammar – What are subjects and predicates?

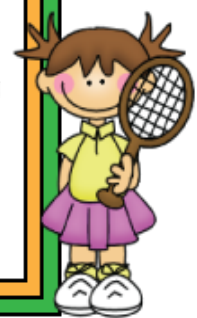
