Group two –pessimistic, optimistic, ignorant, property, substance,

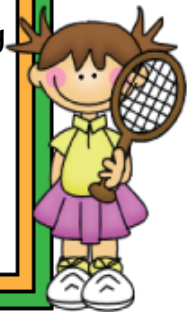


### Science & S.S
