Reading- Readers use the language of a nonfiction topic

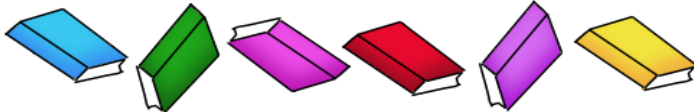
-Readers use text features to notice and understand keywords
