touch, twice

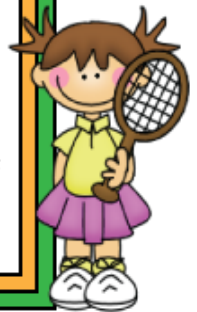
Group Two– thermometer, classify,
